Achievements:

For over 15 years, Remsoft has been developing software for sustainable management of long-term assets; originally developed for forestry it has found application for other long-term assets such as highways. With sustainability in mind, Remsoft's software has contributed greatly to more responsible land management on an international scale, not surprisingly then, what they've done on a local scale is equally impressive.

Accumulating an impressive 25 credits, Remsoft has achieved Silver status within Green Shops! To do so, Remsoft drew upon their philosophy of sustainable growth to ensure that their local workplace was up to par with the environmentally conscious software they produce. The Fredericton team implemented a host of actionable items including, promoting an active transport strategy (more than half of the employees either walk or bike to work!), and initiating their own plastic recycling program. Also, they have implemented a no-idling policy for delivery vehicles, and have installed a timer on their bathroom light!

In comparison to what Remsoft's software can achieve on a global level, implementing small things like recycling and efficient lighting may seem trivial, but have you ever heard the saying "every little bit counts", it certainly holds true in this case!

Currently Implemented Actionable Items:

1. Install a programmable thermostat
2. Install timers on all non-essential electrical appliances
3. Install industry-specific energy efficient equipment
4. Implemented a recycling program
5. Promote an efficient transport strategy
6. Implement a no-idling policy
7. Install aerators on all faucets
8. Install industry-specific water efficient equipment
9. Increase provision of environmentally certified products
